

Class Cohort Locations



Parent/Guardian:

We are so excited to be welcoming back our students next week! While this back to school will look different than previous ones, our goal remains the same – a great start to the school year for all of our students!

- When your child(ren) come to school on the first day (and every day after) they will need to immediately go to their cohort area on the field or the playground.
- To make the first few days easier, we wanted to provide you with a map of the cohort locations.
- These cohort locations will be marked by coloured markings on the fence post and a coloured sign with teacher name. When you come on the first day look for your colour!
- It is important that we minimize the number of people on our playground. Staff will be at entry points welcoming students on to the playground. Students in grades 1-3 may have one parent/guardian/older sibling escort them to their cohort area. Please review the map with students in grades 4-8 who will need to find their cohort area independently.
- Students will be in these cohort areas with their individual classes during recess in order to maintain physical distancing.
- At the end of the day students will be dismissed from these cohort areas. Students in grades 1-3 may have one parent/guardian/older sibling pick them up from their cohort area. Students in grades 4-8 will be dismissed from their cohort area. Please find a location outside of the playground to meet up if you have several children being dismissed who need to meet up.
