Career Pathways is a one-year program that provides a supportive and empowering postsecondary pathway. Designed specifically for students with a learning disability, autism, mental health challenges, or who have faced challenges with a traditional learning environment, who wish to develop academic and career-ready skills for further post-secondary studies and employment.

The Career Pathways program focuses on preparing graduates for both career and educational opportunities by developing personal, social, academic and career related strengths and skills.
