

Making a Reading Video

Today I would like you to make a reading video. I am asking you to do a video that is a little bit longer because I am not hearing you read at school anymore, so I need a longer recording to be able to find your celebrations and your next steps.

****If you do not have a tablet, ipad, or phone, or anything that will record your voice or take a video, please let me know, so we can find another way to help you with your French reading.****

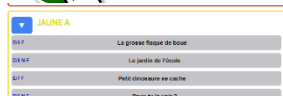
Success Criteria for Reading Recordings

<u>Success Criteria</u>	<u>Examples</u>
I use strategies if I get stuck on a word	I sound it out, look for syllables, break it into pieces, etc.
I can read smoothly, but I also stop when I should.	I do not stop after every word or two. I read in phrases (about 4-8 words in a row). I do have short stops at periods and when a pause makes the sentence make more sense.
I can read at about the speed I speak.	I read at a speed that a person listening to me can understand me, and stays interested. I read not too quickly, not too slowly, just right.
I add expression when I read.	I change my voice so the book makes more sense and is more interesting.

How to Make a Recording

If you have a device that records, please follow the instructions below. It is easier if you have a helper. If not, just set the device on a table near you so we can hear your voice.

1) Ask your helper to start recording (probably a video), then wait a second or two for it to start (often we can't hear whatever you say in the first second or two).



2) Tell us what colour you are reading from in je lis, and the title of your book, so we can find it.



3) Read your book. Your helper can set the ipad to film the words, or just show the title then put the device flat on the desk. We need to hear your voice, so you don't need to be looking at the screen.



4) Your helper will tell you when you are at 3 minutes, and you can stop, even if you are not done your book. If you are really close to finishing and want to finish, you may, but please don't do any videos longer than 5 minutes. (It takes a lot of memory on your device.)



5) Listen to your video to make sure you like it. If not, do a new recording. (Remember it is okay to have mistakes. Mistakes are normal, so I wouldn't do more than 2 or 3 tries.)



6) Hand your video in to your Portfolio. You do this exactly the same as you have been doing to send us pictures. We will listen to it and give you feedback, then you can see it in your portfolio. After you see it in your portfolio, (within a day or two), you can delete it off of your device to make more memory space for other things.
