Dimes

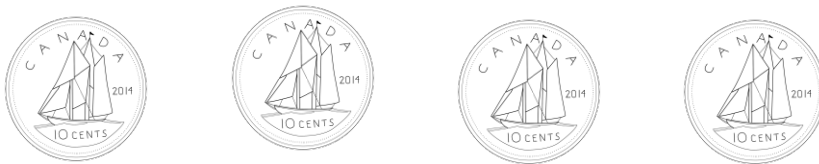


A dime is worth ten cents.
