




Mother's Day - Craft Activity

1. Get a piece of scrap paper and fold it in half like a hamburger.

2. Place your hand on the folded paper. Your thumb and pointer finger **MUST** be on the folded side of the paper. Make sure your thumb and pointer finger are hanging off of the edge of the paper a little.

3. Trace your hand with a pencil (if you have one). Once again, make sure that your thumb and your pointer finger are on the folded side of the paper.

4. Once you have triple checked that your thumb and pointer finger are on the folded side take your time and cut out your handprint with scissors.

5. Your handprint
should look like this.



6. Unfold it and it
should look like this.

7. Flip it upside down.
Now the space
between your thumbs
should look like a
heart.



8. Glue or tape it to
another piece of
paper or construction
paper.

9. Decorate it for your Mom or an important person in your life
