One day Gina's and Danny's mom and dad went away. Their grandmother came from Italy to stay. She brought a toy airplane for Gina and an airport for Danny.

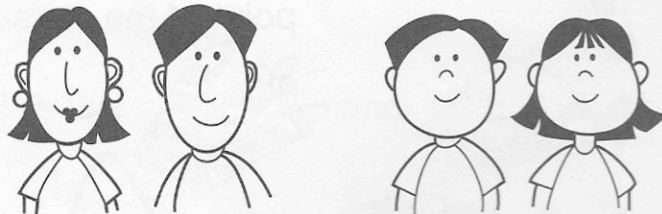
"May I play with your airplane?" asked Danny.
