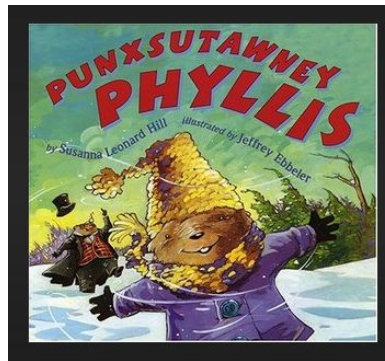

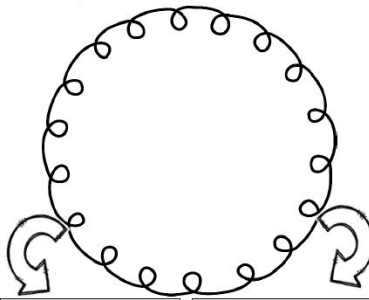

Doubles Plus 1

Look at the example:

$$7 + 8 = ?$$

These numbers sit side by side in a counting by ones pattern.

The strategy is to double the smallest number and then add 1 more.

So, if $7 + 7 = 14$, plus 1 more
 $= 15$
