

Are and Our

The words **are** and **our** sound very similar but have different meanings.

The word **are** is a form of the verb, *to be*.

examples: We are ready to clean the car.

Are you going to wax the car too?

The word **our** means "belonging to us."

examples: My brother and I washed our car.

Our clothes were soaking wet.
