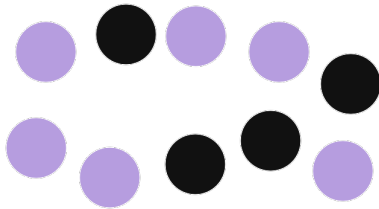


Rates and Ratios – Quiz Review
