

 two coaches and mentors. Your team will need to decide what two adults will be
 spending the day with the students. NOTE: At least one adult coach is required to
 supervise the team at all times during the tournament.
- Schedule of Events and/or a Program Book: Your team will be provided information about the tournament day, including a competition schedule.
