The next page serves as a cover for the entire packet for kids.

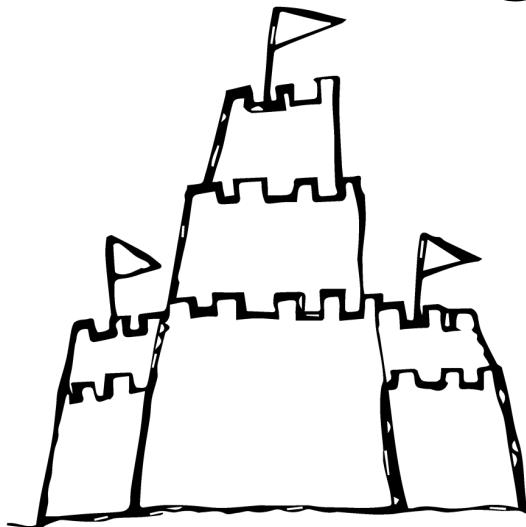
The next eight pages can be used to keep math skills sharp! They can be done every day or at least once a week.
