## Visual learners benefit from:

	colour coding notebooks are using coloured tabs in binders
	using graphic organizers to represent information
	information presented to them using graphs, pictures, flow charts
	symbols
	colour coding information when creating graphic representations
	(ie. tables, flow charts, mind maps)
	making their own visual representations of information
	using flash cards
	highlighting important information
	drawing symbols or shapes around key information
	using dry erase board with coloured markers
	writing down key words and phrases and reviewing notes
	using sticky notes to draw pictures of what you have read or
	learned
	using visually stimulating media such as videos, computers, and
	iPads
	manipulating letter, words, sentences and paragraphs by cutting
	them out and putting them in the appropriate order or sorting
	them
