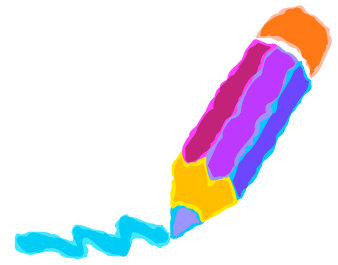


Visual Learning Strategies



Visual learners benefit from:

- ☐ colour coding notebooks are using coloured tabs in binders
- ☐ using graphic organizers to represent information
- ☐ information presented to them using graphs, pictures, flow charts, symbols
- ☐ colour coding information when creating graphic representations (ie. tables, flow charts, mind maps)
- ☐ making their own visual representations of information
- ☐ using flash cards
- ☐ highlighting important information
- ☐ drawing symbols or shapes around key information
- ☐ using dry erase board with coloured markers
- ☐ writing down key words and phrases and reviewing notes
- ☐ using sticky notes to draw pictures of what you have read or learned
- ☐ using visually stimulating media such as videos, computers, and iPads
- ☐ manipulating letter, words, sentences and paragraphs by cutting them out and putting them in the appropriate order or sorting them
