Part 3: Conclusion (The speaker wraps up by summarizing the main points the audience needs to keep in mind. The final impression you leave on your audience is important!)	
A. Signal the close of the speech (use a simple transition sentence that lets the audience know the speech is nearly finished)	
B. Reinforce the main points (remind the audience about the most important things they have just heard)	
C. End strongly (use a brief story, example, quotation, or encourage the audience to do something to follow up on what they have just heard)
