- Masks Students are encouraged to bring an extra mask or two in case their masks need to be need to be changed throughout the day.
- Water Bottles Please send a reusable water bottle filled with water, clearly
  labelled with child's name. Children will be expected to take their water bottle home
  daily for washing and refilling.
- Boomerang Lunches and Snacks Please send lunches and snacks in containers that
  are clearly marked with your child's name. All containers should be able to be opened
  easily by your child without assistance. Everything not eaten, including any garbage will
  be returning home with your child. This would be a great time for us to focus on litter
  less lunches by using reusable containers. All containers need to be clearly marked with
  your child's name.

- Gym/Daily Physical Activity (DPA) In order to limit the amount of things your child has to carry, it would be helpful if your child wore running shoes and comfortable clothes to school every day. Change rooms will not be available.

- Classroom Supplies Your child will be supplied with a bin that will only be for your child for the school year. Students will need to have classroom supplies for their exclusive use only that they can leave at school. Below is a list of supplies that would be useful for your child to own for their own classroom use. All supplies need to be clearly marked with your child's name.
- Pencil Case
- Crayons
- Pencil Crayons and pencil sharpener
- Washable Markers
- Scissors
- Glue sticks
- Extra pencils
- Erasers
- Clean old sock to personal use for students to use to clean dry erase marker off white board. I usually
  use white athletic socks because they are thicker and they do a good job erasing the dry erase markers
  from white boards.
- Small package of Facial Tissues for personal use
- Hand sanitizer for personal use
- Students may bring a device to use for educational purposes in the classroom.
