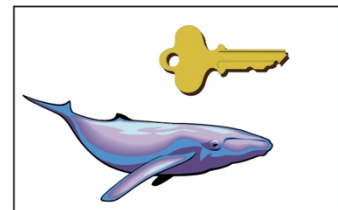
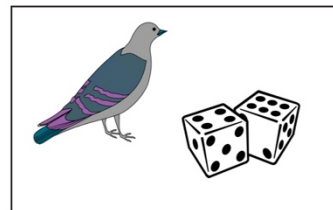
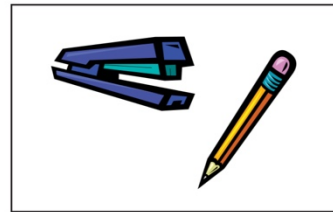
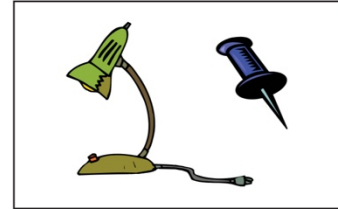


Circle the object that is heavier.
