

Home Programming suggestions for: **Present Progressive Verbs (is + verb + ing)**

- Photo albums look at family photos together and talk about what the people are doing in the pictures (e.g., She <u>is smiling</u>, The dad <u>is carrying</u> his baby, The mom <u>is</u> <u>fixing</u> the pipes.)
- 2. Story time when reading books together take turns describing the pictures using the present progressive (<u>is</u> + <u>verb</u> + <u>ing</u>) as much as you can to describe the pictures (e.g., Grandma *is riding* a bike.)
- 3. Simon Says take turns giving each other silly instructions. When doing the actions tell each other what you are doing (e.g. Look mommy *is jumping*).
- 4. When going for walks, playing at the park or even going for a drive, talk about the people, animals and the things you see. For example, 'The squirrel <u>is climbing</u>', 'The lady <u>is driving</u>' or 'The dog <u>is barking</u>'.
- 5. Playing with action figures or dolls. During pretend play opportunities label what the dolls/figures are doing. For example, 'The doll <u>is eating</u>', 'Superman <u>is jumping</u>' etc.
- 6. Routines while getting dressed, making dinner or bathing, make an effort to describe to your child what you are doing. For example, 'Daddy <u>is washing</u>', 'Daddy <u>is pulling</u> up his socks', 'Mommy <u>is turning</u> on the water' etc. Encourage your child to repeat you and/or talk about what they are doing too!
