

Fan Sound

(Air bloves out between the top teeth and bottom lip like a fan 'FFF')

HOW TO MAKE THE F SOUND

- 1. Put your top teeth on your bottom lip
- 2. Turn your voice 'off' and blow quiet air ('FFF')



Practice Tips

- Hold your hand in front of your mouth to feel the puff of air when you make your 'F' sound
- Use a mirror to watch your top teeth rest on your bottom lip
