Vacuum Sound

(Voice buzzes like a vacuum 'VVVROOM')



HOW TO MAKE THE V SOUND

1. Put your top teeth on your bottom lip
2. Turn your voice 'on' and blow noisy air ('VVV')



Practice Tips

- Place your hand gently on your throat to feel the vibration when you turn your voice 'on'
- Use a mirror to watch your top teeth rest on your bottom lip
