Articulation		Phonics Studio (\$2.79) Phonics Studio makes learning how to pronounce words fun and easy. It not only targets speech sounds, but works on building vocabulary too with it's over 2,500 gorgeous flash cards.
		Minimal Pairs for Speech Therapy (\$1.39) Minimal pairs are words that differ by only one phoneme or single feature signaling a change in meaning. Minimal pairs are useful for children to see that the word being produced differs in meaning than the word that was intended. (e.g., 'swing' vs. 'wing', 'tea' vs 'key').
		ArtikPix (free sample) Additional sound decks are \$3.99, or \$39.99 for the full version ArtikPix is an engaging articulation app with flashcard and matching activities for children with speech sound delays. ArtikPix is a free application offering the 'b' deck with 23 additional decks available as In App Purchases: ch, d, f, g, h, j, k, l, l-blends, m, n, p, r, r-blends, s, s-blends, sh, t, th, v, w, y, z.
		Speedy Speech – /L/ Lite, /R/ Lite, /S/ Lite (free only on iPad) The Speedy Speech™ App is available for free for the /l/, /r/, and /s/ sounds in lite mode. This app has a hierarchical model of implementation that begins with auditory bombardment and discrimination, and then moves to words. The full version is available for purchase however, the Lite version offers many practice items.
Vocabulary		Let's Name Things (free) This colorful, educational vocabulary App has 52 illustrated picture flash cards. These cards help with practice of vocabulary, categorizing, and thinking skills.
		Name that Category (\$2.79) This is a colorful, educational vocabulary App with 56 illustrated picture flash cards. Have students fill in the blank to practice describing, categorizing, and organizational skills.
