Grade 8 Sketchbook

Criteria

In visual arts class you will be required to maintain a sketchbook of original drawings. Your sketchbook will be an independent project that you will complete throughout the year. You must keep all of your drawings inside your sketchbook. Plan your ideas carefully as you have a limited number of pages to work with. You may use whatever materials you would like to complete your sketches. The subject of your drawings is open, however, you will need to represent each of the styles of the artists listed below in your work. You will need to research each artist prior to starting, to develop a sense of their artistic style. On the back of each drawing, include a title, date, and the name of the artist you are representing. Your signature should be on the bottom right hand corner on the drawing itself. You will need to work on your independent project throughout the year as your sketchbook must be fully completed by the end of April. If you have any questions about your independent project, do not hesitate to ask (prior to the deadline).
