Engaging English Language Learners in Distance Learning

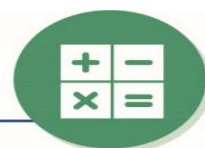

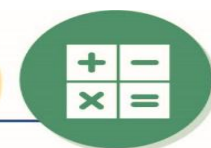
