The Ontario Agricultural College is pleased to offer scholarships for students entering any OAC undergraduate degree program with a minimum 75% admission average who are/were registered in the Specialist High Skills Major. These scholarships, of \$1,000 each, have been established by the OAC Dean's Office Liaison Program to recognize students who are/were registered in the Specialist High Skills Major.

The scholarships will be awarded each fall to the three students with the highest admission average entering first year of any OAC program and applied directly to the student's financial account in two equal payments in the fall and winter semesters.
