College 101 (Introduction to Post Secondary Experiences)

This course will help students to develop the necessary skills required to pursue a successful personal pathway to post-secondary education. Within the course, students will learn personal, academic, critical thinking, and digital literacy techniques that promote and foster favourable outcomes in a college or university setting. Students will also develop essential employability skills, positive coping strategies to combat stress, and will learn how to manage their personal ecological footprint with an added emphasis on nutrition and food sustainability practices.

Introduction to Construction,

This is a foundational class that introduces the student to the basics of the construction trades. The students will be introduced to and complete a building project according to drawings and specifications required for the project. Curriculum will cover identifying and selecting appropriate materials and finishes for the project including the construction and assembly of the project using various methods and fasteners. The student will also learn the basics of plumbing and concrete work as would be used in a real-life construction project.
