This program introduces young people to the concepts of equity, diversity, and inclusion (EDI) through interactive activities, discussions, and videos. It teaches them the importance of these values in our society and equips them with tools to challenge stereotypes and biases, combat discrimination, and foster a welcoming environment in their schools and communities. Students completing the program will receive a Certificate of Completion.



THIS 4-PART TRAINING WILL:

- Equip youth with knowledge and skills to become positive change-makers in their schools and communities.
- Build a network of EDI and Anti-Racism (AR) Ambassadors across the city, connecting them with community organizations.
- Empower youth to drive change.
- Provide “train the trainer” sessions for youth who have completed the program.

TRAINING COMPONENTS: The program includes three (3) 2.5-hour workshops, featuring interactive activities including group discussion, videos, and guest speakers.
