# Stop sign

---

- A stop sign is found at most intersections in the community.
- This is where we stop to make sure it is safe to cross the road.

# Traffic Light

---

- Traffic lights tell drivers and pedestrians what they must do at an intersection.
- They tell us when to stop and go.

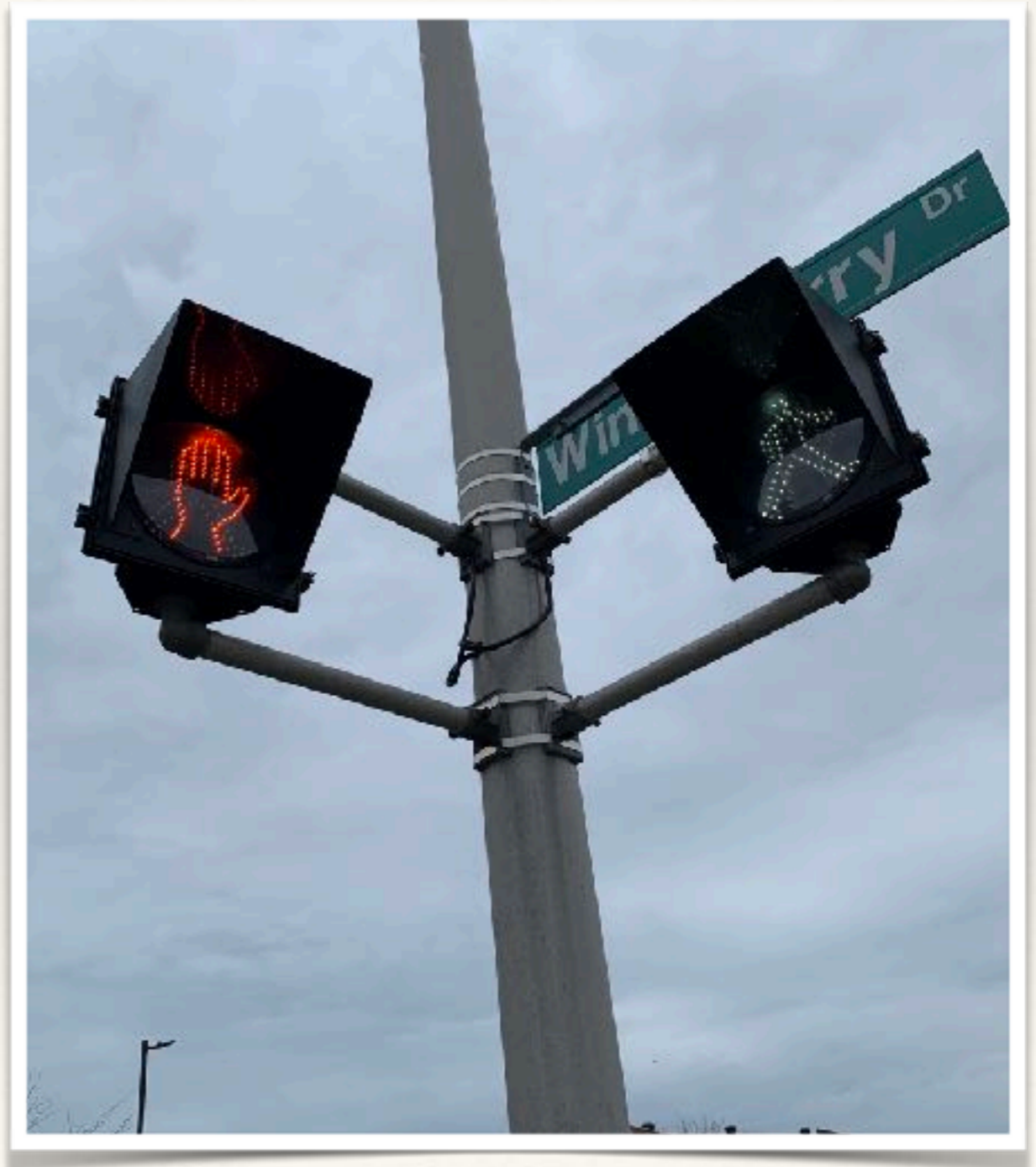

# Pedestrian Signals

---

- Pedestrian signals help pedestrians cross at an intersection with traffic lights.



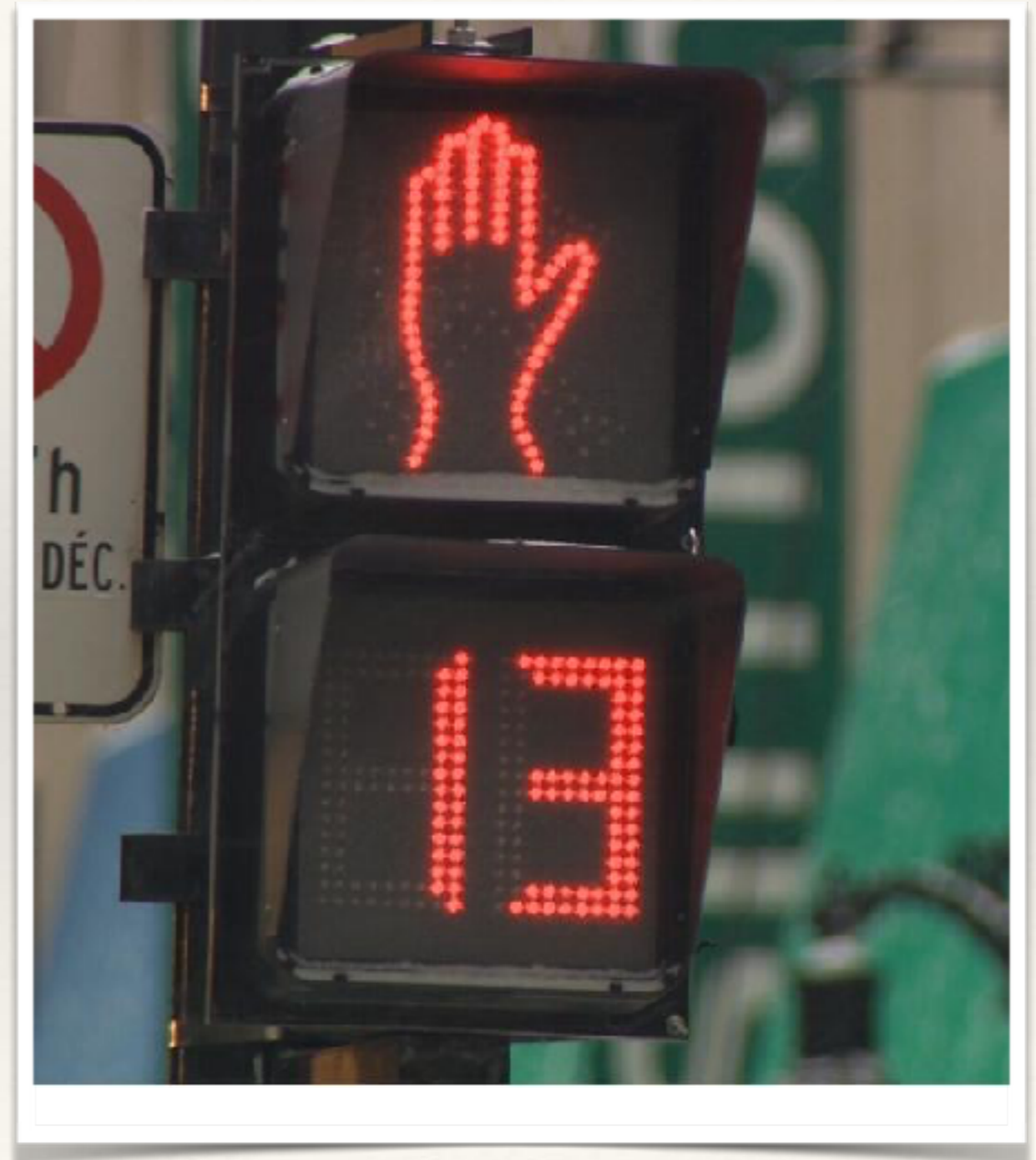
# Pedestrian Signals: Walk Signal

- A pedestrian facing a walk signal may cross the road in the direction of the signal.
- This means it is safe to cross the road.



# Pedestrian Signals: Do Not Walk Signal

- A flashing or steady orange hand symbol means pedestrian must NOT begin to cross.
- This means it is not safe to cross the road.

# Bike Lane Sign

---

- A bike lane sign indicates which lane you can ride your bike in.
- It is important to ride safety as you are sharing the road with other vehicles.



# Pedestrian Crossing

- A pedestrian sign warns drivers that pedestrians might be crossing.
- Remember it is only safe to cross when the road is clear or the vehicles have come to a stop.



# School Zone Sign

- A school zone sign warns drivers they are entering a school zone and must slow down and drive with extra caution.
- It is still important to make sure the road is clear before crossing.

# Street Sign

---

- Street signs tell you the name of the street you are on.



# Bus Stop Sign & Shelter

- The Hamilton Street Railway (HSR) is a public transportation agency in Hamilton Ontario.
- We wait for the bus to come at designated areas like this one.
- It is best to travel with an adult until you are comfortable navigating the bus routes on your own.



# Hamilton Public Library

- A library sign shows the route to the library.

# Hospital Sign

---

- A hospital sign shows the route to the hospital.
- It can also be found on a hospital building.



# Emergency Exit Sign

- An emergency exit sign indicates the closest exit in case of a fire or other emergency.

# Accessibility Sign

---

- An accessibility sign shows facilities that are accessible by wheelchair.
- These symbol are most commonly found on restroom doors, buses and in parking lots.

# Men's Restroom

---

- The symbol of a man indicates this restroom is for boys and men only.



# Women's Restroom

- The symbol of a woman indicates this restroom is for girls and women only.



# Universal/Accessible Restroom

- The symbol of a man, woman and a person in a wheelchair indicates this restroom is for anyone and is accessible.
