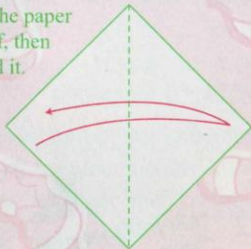


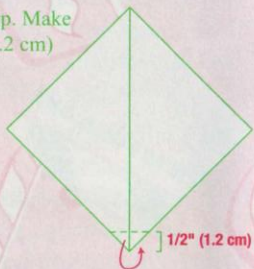
Santa Claus

Use a piece of red paper for this design. Start with the colored side down.

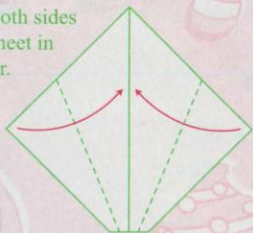
- 1** Fold the paper in half, then unfold it.



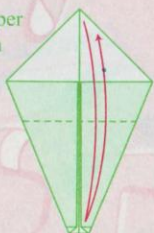
- 2** Fold under the bottom tip. Make the fold about 1/2 inch (1.2 cm) from the bottom point.



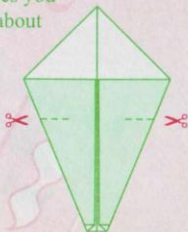
- 3** Fold in both sides so they meet in the center.



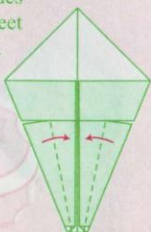
- 4** Fold the paper in half, then unfold it.



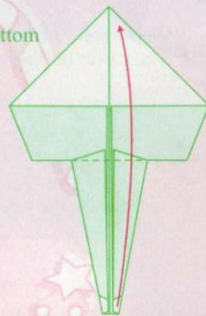
- 5** Use scissors to cut along the creases you made in Step 4, as shown. Cut in about halfway on each side of the paper.



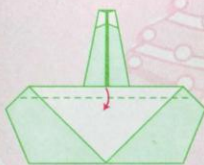
- 6** Fold both sides in so they meet in the center.



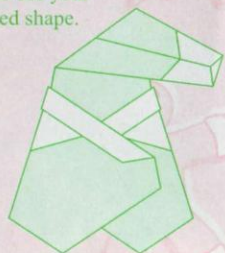
- 7** Fold up the bottom flap. Turn the paper over.



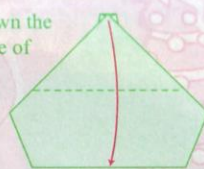
- 9** Fold down the middle edge. Turn the paper over.



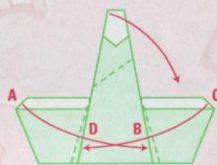
- 11** Turn the paper over to see your finished shape.



- 8** Fold down the top piece of paper.



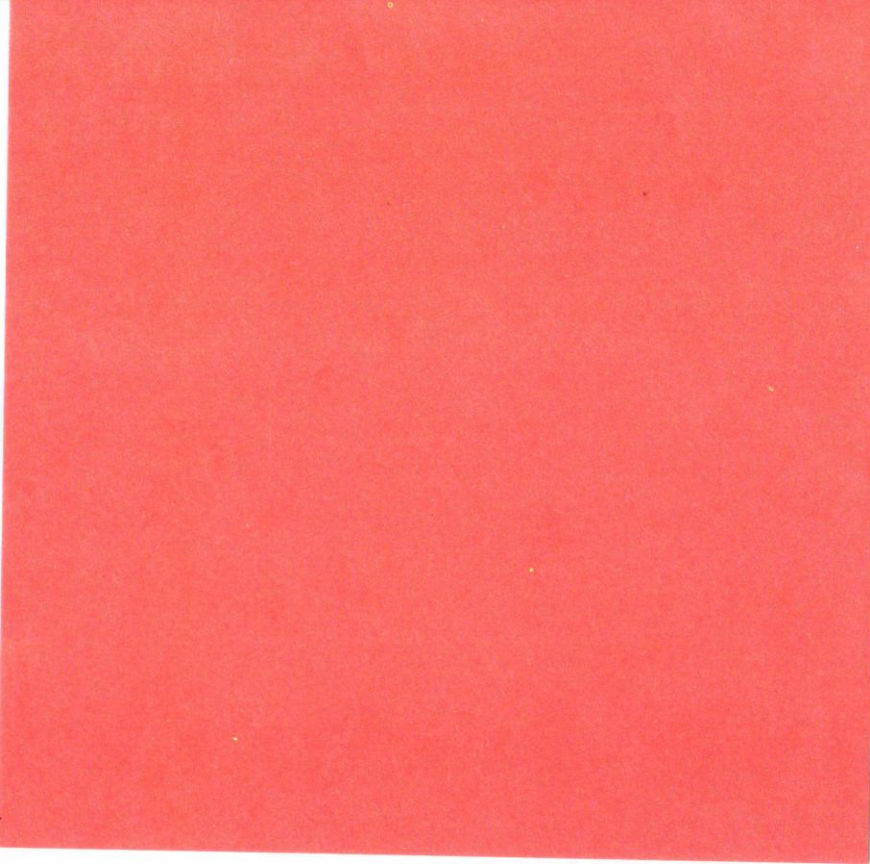
- 10** Fold in both side flaps. Make sure edge A does not overlap edge B, and edge C does not overlap edge D. Fold over the top flap.

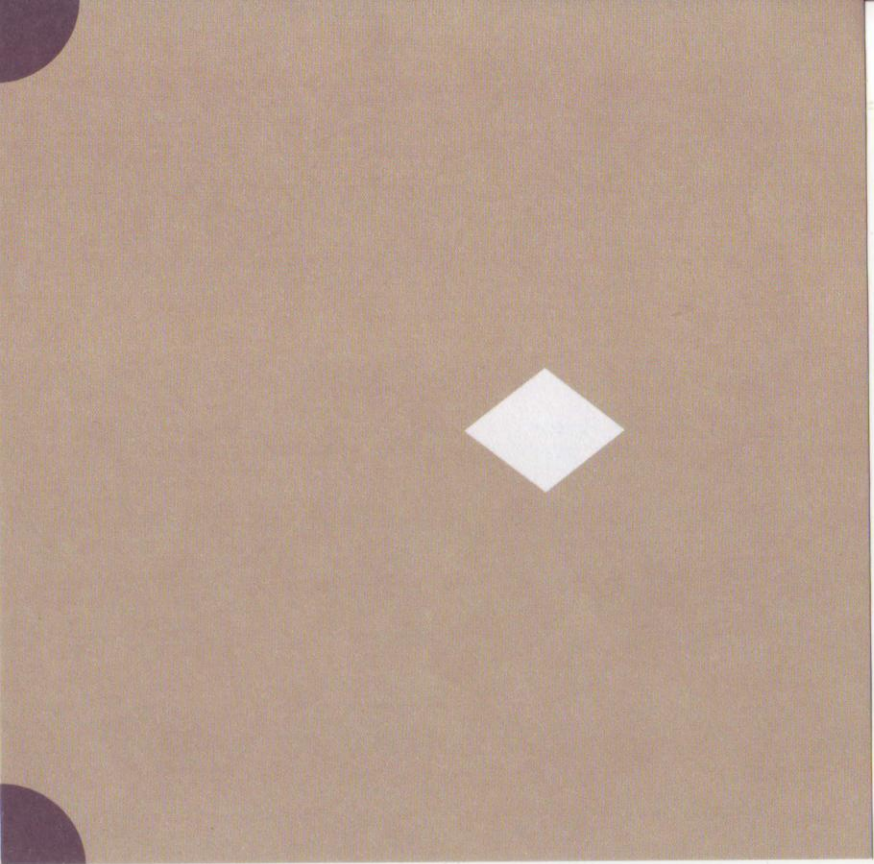


Finishing It Off

Draw a face on Santa. Don't forget to add twinkling eyes, a big round nose, and a bushy moustache and eyebrows. Set Santa by the fireplace. Then stick some cookies and chocolate nearby so he will have something to eat.



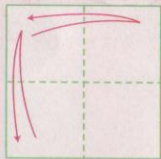




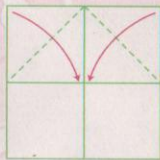
Christmas Stocking

Use a piece of red paper for this design. Start with the colored side down.

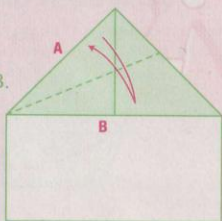
- 1 Fold the paper in half, then unfold it. Repeat in the other direction.



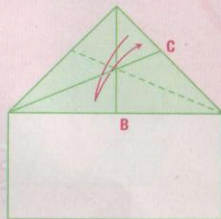
- 2 Fold in both top corners so they meet in the center.



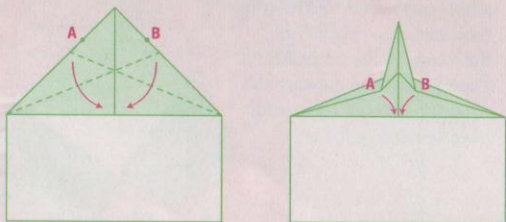
- 3 Fold down the top flap so that edge A lines up with edge B. Crease and unfold.



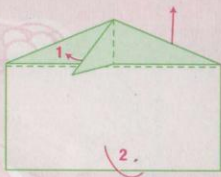
- 4 Fold down the top flap so that edge C lines up with edge B. Crease and unfold.



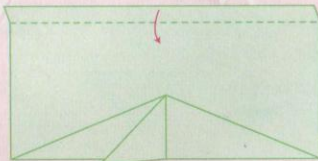
- 5 Fold in along the creases you made in steps 3 and 4 so that point A meets point B in the center of the paper.



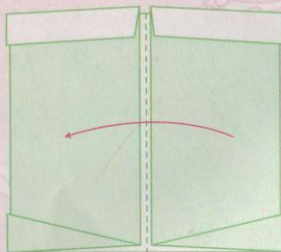
- 6 Fold over the middle part. Fold back the bottom part of the paper.



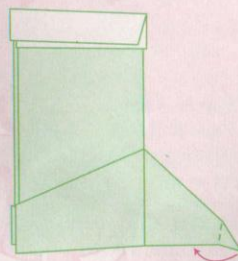
- 7 Fold down the top edge. Turn the paper over.



- 9 Fold over the right flap.



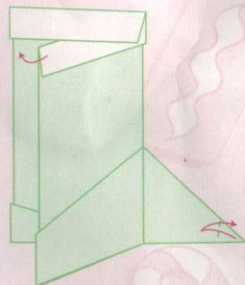
- 11 Tuck in the point along the crease you just made.



- 8 Fold in both sides so they meet in the center.



- 10 Tuck the top of the flap into the pocket, as shown. Fold and unfold the right point to make a crease.










Use the stickers to fill your stocking with candy canes and other goodies. Hang your festive holiday stocking by the fireplace!












Santa's Reindeer


Use two pieces of brown patterned paper for this design. For both sections, start with the paper as shown.


Front Section

- 1 Turn the paper over. 
- 2 Fold the paper in half, then unfold it. Repeat in the other direction. 
- 3 Fold over the right edge so it lines up along the center crease. 
- 4 Fold in the top and bottom edges so they meet in the center. 
- 5 Fold over all four side flaps as shown. Crease sharply, then unfold. 
- 6 Pull out the two inner right flaps as shown. Press flat. 
- 7 Inside reverse fold along the left creases. Turn the paper over. 
- 8 Fold over the right flap. Turn the paper over. 
- 9 Fold in the top and bottom flaps so they meet in the center. 
- 10 Fold over the top right flaps. 
- 11 Fold the paper in half. 
- 12 Gently pull up on the center flap. At the same time, fold along crease A so that point B meets point C. 

Rear Section

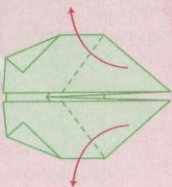
- 1 Turn the paper over. 
- 2 Fold the paper in half, then unfold it. Repeat in the other direction. 
- 3 Fold over the right edge so it lines up along the center crease, then unfold it. 
- 4 Fold over the left edge so it lines up with the crease you made in Step 3. 
- 5 Fold over the right edge. 
- 6 Fold in the top and bottom edges so they meet in the center. 
- 7 Fold over the right flaps as shown. Crease sharply, then unfold. 
- 8 Pull out the two inner flaps as shown. Press flat. 
- 9 Fold in the left corners. 

- 13 Fold down the left flap. Repeat with the flap on the other side of the paper. 

- 14 Fold over the flap. Repeat with the flap on the other side of the paper. Tuck in the right point. 

Santa's Reindeer

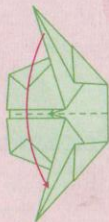
10 Fold out the right flaps.



11 Fold in the right corners.



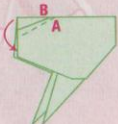
12 Fold the paper in half.



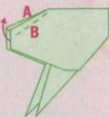
13 Fold and unfold to make creases as shown.



14 Tuck in the point along crease A.

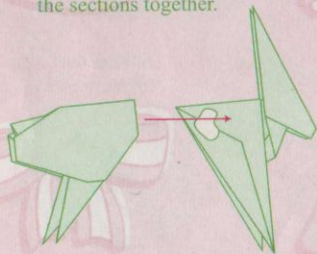


15 Pull out the point along crease B.

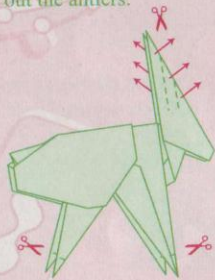


Assembling the Reindeer

1 Put a little bit of glue on the back part of the front section. Slide the rear section onto the front section. Squeeze to glue the sections together.



2 Use scissors to cut the reindeer's antlers and trim the bottoms of its legs. Fold out the antlers.



Finishing It Off

Add a festive bow or wreath sticker to your reindeer's neck. Cut out a round plate and add some cookie, chocolate and candy cane stickers. Your reindeer wants to eat some tasty treats!





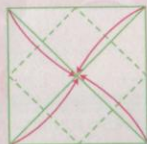
Poinsettia

Use a piece of red, green, and yellow paper for this design. Start with the colored side down.

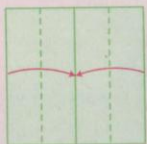
- 1** Fold the paper in half, then unfold it. Repeat in the other direction.



- 2** Fold in all four corners so they meet in the center. Turn the paper over. Rotate slightly to the right.



- 3** Fold in both sides so they meet in the center.



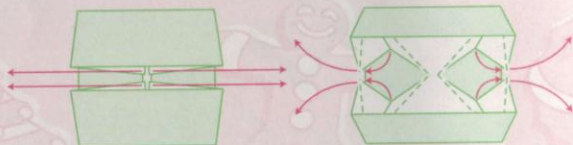
- 4** Fold down the top and bottom edges so they meet in the center.



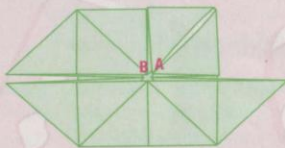
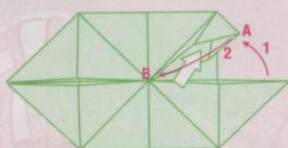
- 5** Fold over the top flaps as shown. Crease sharply, then unfold.



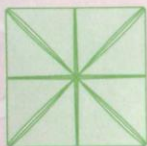
- 6** Pull out all four inner flaps as shown. Press down to flatten.



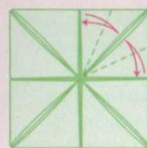
- 7** Lift the top right flap so it stands straight up. Put your finger inside the flap. Press down to flatten so that A meets B.



- 8** Repeat Step 7 with the other three flaps.



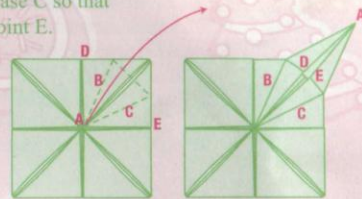
- 9** Fold in both sides of the top right flap so they meet in the center. Crease sharply, then unfold.



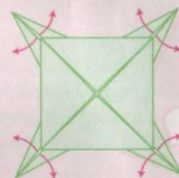
- 11** Repeat steps 9 and 10 with the other three flaps. Turn the paper over.



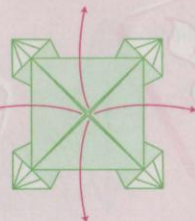
- 10** Pull up point A. At the same time, fold along crease B and crease C so that point D meets point E. Press to flatten.



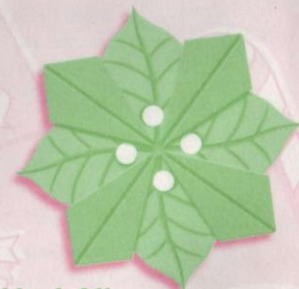
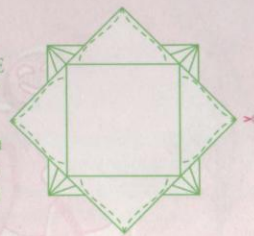
- 12** Pull out the flaps on all four points as shown. Press to flatten.



- 13** Fold out the center flaps.



- 14** Use scissors to cut the flaps into leaf shapes. ONLY CUT THE TOP SHEET OF PAPER. When you're done, turn the paper over to see your finished poinsettia.



Finishing It Off

Stick the poinsettia to your front door as a symbol of welcome for holiday visitors. You can even make and arrange several poinsettias for an extra-festive touch.

Angel

Use a piece of white paper with blue trim for this design. Start with the paper as shown.

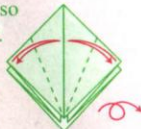
- 1 Turn the paper over.



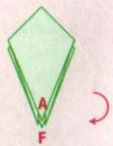
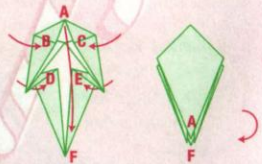
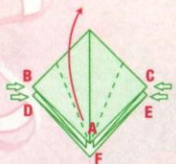
- 2 Follow steps 1 through 4 of the Christmas Tree on pages 8-9.



- 3 Fold in both side flaps so they meet in the center. Crease sharply, then unfold. Turn the paper over and repeat on the other side.



- 4 Pull up point A. Inside reverse fold along the creases so that point B meets point C and point D meets point E. Push down point A to meet point F. Rotate the paper one-half turn to the right.



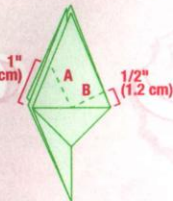
- 5 Fold down the top flap.



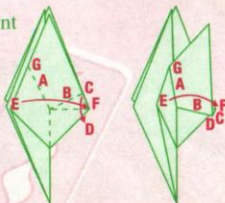
- 6 Fold over the right flap.



- 7 Fold the top flap as shown to make crease A and crease B.



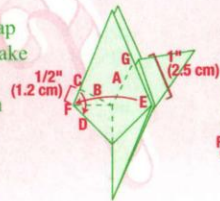
- 8 Pull down the paper so that point C meets point D. At the same time, fold over the left flap so that point E meets point F. Flatten along crease B.



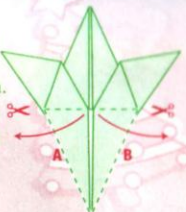
- 9 Fold over the left flap.



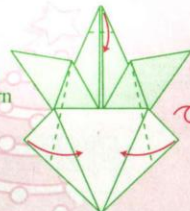
- 10 Fold the top flap as shown to make crease A and crease B. Then repeat Step 8.



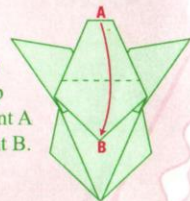
- 11 Use scissors to cut the top layer of the paper as shown. Fold out both flaps along crease A and crease B.



- 12 Fold down the top point. Fold in the side flaps. Turn the paper over.



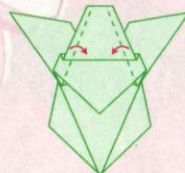
- 13 Fold down the top flap so that point A meets point B.



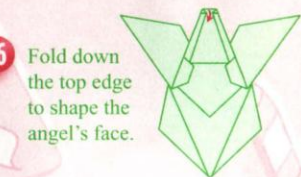
- 14 Fold up the middle flap.



- 15 Fold in both edges.



- 16 Fold down the top edge to shape the angel's face.



Finishing It Off

Set several of these pretty angels around your home where they will remind you every day to be grateful for Christmas and everything it stands for. Remember, angels were a part of the very first Christmas celebration—more than 2,000 years ago!



Christmas Tree

Use three pieces of green patterned paper for this design. Start with the colored sides down.

Making the Layers

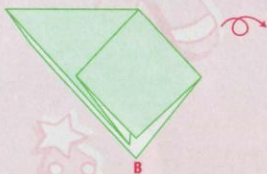
- 1 Fold one piece of paper in half.



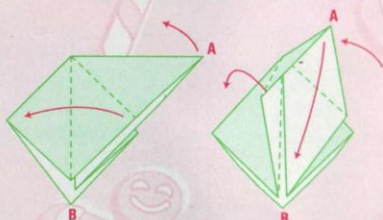
- 2 Fold the paper in half again.



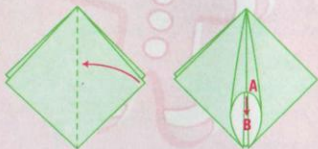
- 3 Lift the top flap so it stands straight up. Put your finger inside the white part of the flap. Press down to flatten so that A meets B. Turn the paper over.



- 4 Repeat Step 3 with the flap on the other side.



- 5 Lift the right flap so it stands straight up. Put your finger inside the white part of the flap. Press down to flatten so that A meets B.



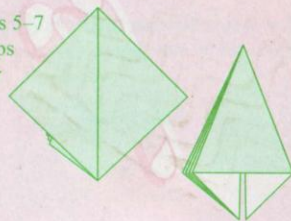
- 6 Fold over the top left flap.



- 7 Lift the left flap so it stands straight up. Press to flatten just like you did in Step 5. Turn the paper over.



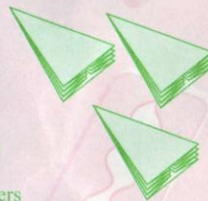
- 8 Repeat steps 5–7 with the flaps on the other side.



- 9 Use scissors to cut off all of the bottom points.



- 10 Repeat steps 1–9 two times with two new pieces of paper. When you're done, you will have three tree layers.



Assembling the Tree

- 1 Slide two of the layers together so the tip of the bottom layer pokes about 1 inch (2.5 cm) into the top layer. Make sure all the flaps on both sides slide into each other, as shown.



- 2 Lift the bottom edge of the top layer. Use a glue stick to smear a little glue on the top point of the lower layer. Press to glue the layers together. Turn the paper over.



- 3 Repeat Step 2 on the other side of the paper.



- 4 Repeat steps 1–3 to add the third layer to the tree.



Finishing It Off

Fan out the flaps to bring your tree to life. Use crayons or markers to draw colorful balls and other ornaments on your tree. Don't forget to add some candy cane stickers. No Christmas tree is complete without them!
